

SUMMARY STATISTICS

FEB. 2010

1. Coverage of Statistics:

All foreign exchange export proceeds and import payments through banks.

2. Comparison with Feb. 2009 of export proceeds and import payments:

Export proceeds totaled US\$ 17,833.1 million, an increase of US\$ 651.1 million or 3.8% (Table 1), as compared with Feb. 2009.

Import payments totaled US\$ 15,751.3 million, an increase of US\$ 1,344.6 million or 9.3% (Table 1), as compared with Feb. 2009.

3. Comparison with Feb. 2009 of export proceeds realized:

Sold for N.T. Dollars US\$ 1,611.2 million, an increase of US\$ 23.3 million or 1.5% (Table 2), as compared with Feb. 2009.

Retained with exporters US\$ 16,221.9 million, an increase of US\$ 627.8 million or 4.0% (Table 2), as compared with Feb. 2009.

4. Comparison with Feb. 2009 of import payments made:

Purchased with N.T. Dollars US\$ 2,535.8 million, a decrease of US\$ 844.8 million or 25.0% (Table 3), as compared with Feb. 2009.

Self-acquired foreign exchange imports US\$ 13,215.5 million, an increase of US\$ 2,189.4 million or 19.9% (Table 3), as compared with Feb. 2009.

5. Foreign exchange exports and imports by type of payment (Table 4):

(1) Exports:

Sight L/C US\$ 1,255.8 million, 7.0% of total exports.

Usance L/C US\$ 912.3 million, 5.1% of total exports.

Collection US\$ 277.6 million, 1.6% of total exports.

Remittance US\$ 15,387.4 million, 86.3% of total exports.

(2) Imports:

Sight L/C US\$ 336.2 million, 2.1% of total imports.

Usance L/C US\$ 2,407.2 million, 15.3% of total imports.

Collection US\$ 141.2 million, 0.9% of total imports.

Remittance US\$ 12,866.7 million, 81.7% of total imports.

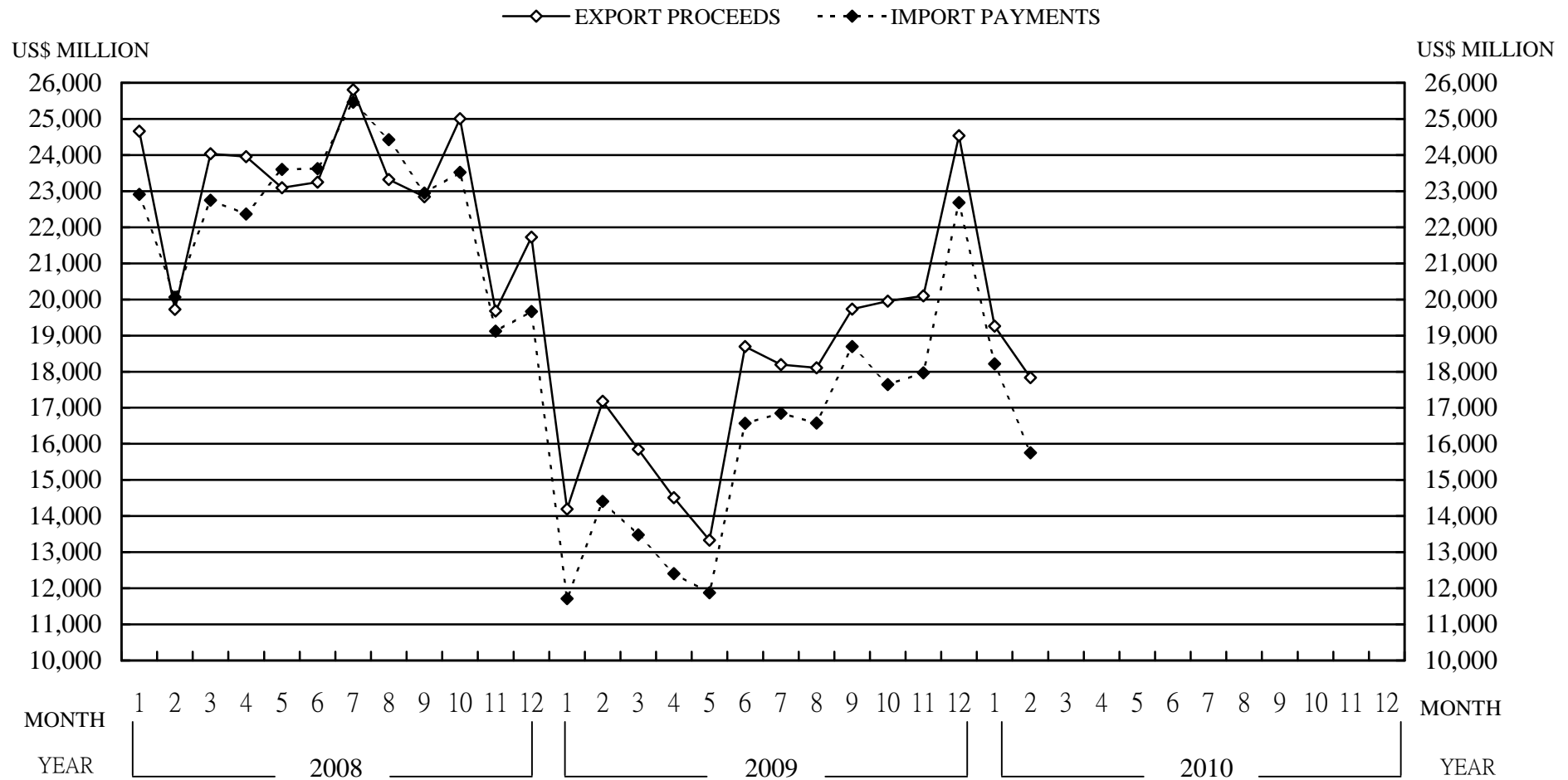
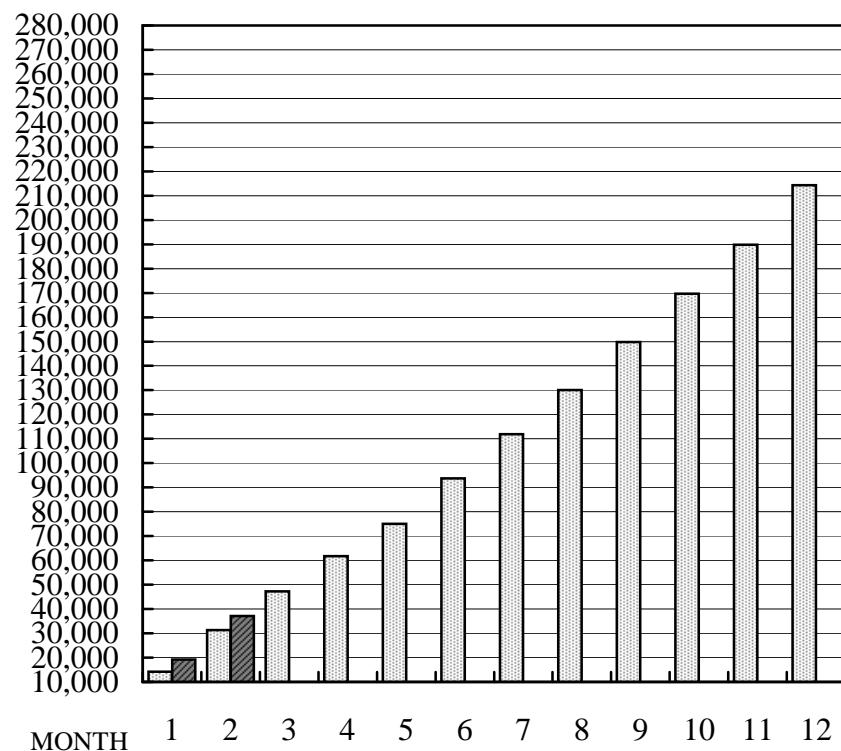
