# SUMMARY STATISTICS

# FEB. 2011

- **1.** Coverage of Statistics:
  - All foreign exchange export proceeds and import payments through banks.
- 2. Comparison with Feb. 2010 of export proceeds and import payments:
- Export proceeds totaled US\$ 19,923.2 million, an increase of US\$ 2,090.0 million or 11.7% (Table 1), as compared with Feb. 2010.

Import payments totaled US\$ 17,026.0 million, an increase of US\$ 1,274.4 million or 8.1% (Table 1), as compared with Feb. 2010.

3. Comparison with Feb. 2010 of export proceeds realized: Sold for N.T. Dollars US\$ 1,737.5 million, an increase of US\$ 124.9 million or 7.7% (Table 2), as compared

with Feb. 2010.

Retained with exporters US\$ 18,185.7 million, an increase of US\$ 1,965.1 million or 12.1% (Table 2), as compared with Feb. 2010.

4. Comparison with Feb. 2010 of import payments made:

Purchased with N.T. Dollars US\$ 2,923.0 million, an increase of US\$ 387.2 million or 15.3% (Table 3), as compared with Feb. 2010.

Self-acquired foreign exchange imports US\$ 14,103.0 million, an increase of US\$ 887.2 million or 6.7% (Table 3), as compared with Feb. 2010.


