Obverse: A portrait of the late President Chiang Kai-Shek forms the main design. The intaglio printing reads "The Republic of China", "The Central Bank of China", "Two Hundred Dollars" and "200".

Reverse: The main design shows the Presidential Office.

- II. The new banknotes are printed by China Engraving & Printing Works. The engraving was made in 2001.
- III. The new banknotes will be circulated simultaneously in Taiwan, Kinmen and Matsu region.
