17. Participation in International Activities

The Republic of China is currently a full member of the Asian Development Bank (ADB), the Central American Bank for Economic Integration (CABEI), and the Conference of Governors of South East Asian Central Banks (SEACEN). The Bank attends the annual meetings, provides training courses, and hosts conferences so as to strengthen financial cooperation and relations with other member countries. In addition, the Bank also plays an active and extensive role in the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB), the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD), and the Bank for International Settlements (BIS), among other international financial organizations.

In 2001, the Bank and the SEACEN Centre jointly held an international seminar on non-performing loan resolution mechanism and its impact on the financial system in Taipei. Major topics discussed in the Seminar included non-performing loans and credit crunch, the non-performing loan resolution mechanism, the role of the public sector, and the impacts on financial and real-estate markets.
